Mass Days and year round	<p style="text-align: center;"><i>“Formal Dress Uniform”</i></p> <p><u>All Grades</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Holy Cross tie • Long or short sleeve light blue oxford shirt (shirt tucked in) • Khaki pants (with belt Grades 2-8) • Navy-blue sweater vest, Navy-blue cardigan, or Navy-blue fleece with Holy Cross patch (zipped low enough so tie shows) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Outside-wear (jackets, hoodies, etc.) is not allowed in the classrooms or at church ○ Holy Cross hoodies and sweatshirts are <u>not allowed</u> with the Formal Dress Uniform • Shoes should be in good condition and fit properly <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ No flip-flops, open-toe sandals, or “Croc” type shoes are permitted (this includes on dress down days) ○ Shoes/sneakers must be of neutral and/or “non-loud” colors (white, blue, gray, brown, or black) • Socks must be worn, and are to be white, black or navy-blue (with left and right socks matching each other) 	<p style="text-align: center;"><i>“Formal Dress Uniform”</i></p> <p><u>Pre-K to 4</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Holy Cross plaid jumper • Navy blue leggings may be worn under jumper if it is cold • Peter Pan collar shirt <p><u>5-8</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Holy Cross plaid skirt • Navy blue leggings may be worn under jumper • “Tuck out” blouse • Navy-blue sweater vest, Navy-blue cardigan, or Navy-blue fleece with Holy Cross patch <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Outside-wear (jackets, hoodies, etc.) is not allowed in the classrooms or at church ○ Holy Cross hoodies and sweatshirts are <u>not allowed</u> with the Formal Dress Uniform <p><u>All Grades</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Shoes should be in good condition and fit properly <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ No flip-flops or open-toe sandals are permitted (this includes on dress down days) ○ Shoes/sneakers must be of neutral and/or “non-loud” colors (white, blue, gray, brown, or black) • Socks must be worn, and are to be white, black or navy-blue (with left and right socks matching each other) • Girls may wear khaki pants during the winter <u>only</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ If this option is chosen they must be PANTS, <u>not</u> leggings ○ If this option is chosen, the Peter Pan collar shirt or tuck-out shirt must be worn with them, with a navy-blue sweater that comes down to mid-thigh

Days</p>	<p>All Grades</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Navy blue sweatpants or navy blue shorts of appropriate mid-thigh length • Navy blue t-shirt (short or long sleeve) or other HC t-shirt with logo (i.e. CSW shirt, team shirt) • Navy blue sweatshirt (optional) • White socks MUST be worn 	<p>All Grades</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Navy blue sweatpants or navy blue shorts of appropriate mid-thigh length • Navy blue t-shirt (short or long sleeve) or other HC t-shirt with logo (i.e. CSW shirt, team shirt) • Navy blue sweatshirt (optional) • White socks MUST be worn
<p>Warm Weather Uniform (Optional) April 1 – October 31 (excluding Mass and PE days)</p>	<p>All Grades</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Khaki knee-length shorts • Polo shirt with Holy Cross patch or insignia • Socks and shoes are under the same rules as Formal Dress Uniform • When Warm Weather Uniform option timeframe starts, students are not allowed to wear outerwear, sweatshirts, jackets, sweaters, fleeces, etc. inside the school or in any classroom. • When Warm Weather Uniform option timeframe starts, students are not allowed to wear the polo shirt with pants 	<p>All Grades</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Khaki skort • Polo shirt with Holy Cross patch or insignia • Socks and shoes are under the same rules as Formal Dress Uniform • When Warm Weather Uniform option timeframe starts, students are not allowed to wear outerwear, sweatshirts, jackets, sweaters, fleeces, etc. inside the school or in any classroom. • When Warm Weather Uniform option timeframe starts, students are not allowed to wear the polo shirt with pants nor leggings.
<p>Jewelry</p>	<p>Earrings and piercings are not allowed for boys</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Earrings are permitted in the ears only <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Large hoop earrings are not allowed ○ Body piercings in other parts of the body are not allowed • Jewelry shall not be unsafe, distracting, excessive, nor representing an offensive idea to our school's Catholic values
<p>Hair</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Unnatural or loud-colored dyed hair coloring is not allowed • Shavings or designs carved into hair are not allowed • Hair should not be over eyes 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Unnatural or loud-colored dyed hair coloring is not permitted • Shavings or designs carved into hair are not allowed • Hair should be worn in a way that keeps it out of the students' eyes
